President's Report-Jan Kane:

- Thanks everyone for a great season. A portion of the banner won belongs to all the parents. There is no way we could have done it without all the parent volunteers.
- Thank you to Maryl and Chris Brennan along with Sara DeVore for all your hard work in the concession stand.
- The craft fair is 12/11. We will need lots of student and parent volunteers to help as this is our biggest fundraiser. I will be posting a Sign Up Genius soon.

Vice President's Report-Andrea Delaney:

- The next restaurant night will be at Gold Star Chili in Edgewood on Monday 12/13 from 4pm to 9pm. We get 15% of the profit. Please consider supporting them as they give us free chili in the concession stand for football games.

Treasurer's Report-Steve Kreinbrink-

- The concession stand did well this fall making a profit of \$16,241.19.
- The last instructor payment of \$6,738.50 was made.
- We made \$369 in donations at the Community Performance.
- Approximately \$4,800 was expensed for the BOA trip to Indianapolis.

- We spent \$55.00 on senior night activities. \$200 was budgeted. Corsages and cake were donated. Thanks to everyone who donated!
- Marching Band was \$6,200 under budget for the season!
- The winter craft fair so far has brought in \$5,524.05. This is our biggest fundraiser
- We will be back in a positive balance soon. It is just a matter of timing.

Director's Report-Sarah Shamblin:

- This season has been my best season in my 5 years at Dixie. This is not just because we won, but because of our parent support and the positivity that the students and parents had. I am looking forward to the future!
- Last night, All State Band auditions took place. This is the highest ensemble a student can audition for in the State. I would like to congratulate the following 7 students who will go on to the second round of auditions in Elizabethtown: Ben Anneken, David Anneken, Logan Kinney, Paul Kreinbrink, Ben Wells, Seth Dousa and Will Comerford.
- If they get through the 2nd round of auditions they will play in Louisville in front of thousands of people!
- Indoor Percussion and Winter Guard clinics have started. Auditions will be Friday, 12/4.
- Fees will be assessed when we find out how many students we will have and it is approved by the School Board.
- The Concert Band will have their performance on 12/17. The students have been working hard on their music for 13 weeks.
- Jazz Band will be on Wednesdays from 3 to 4:30 for any students wishing to participate.
- The Christmas Party will be 12/17 at the Edgewood Senior Center at 6pm. Each family is to bring a food or drink item.

- There will be a White Elephant gift exchange. Each student is being asked to bring a \$5 to \$10 gift to exchange. The gift can be serious or funny, not marked, and not gender specific.
- The basketball season starts after Thanksgiving as will Pep Band. I am working on a list of what games the band will perform at and will get that list out as soon as possible.

- Christa will be heading up the bake sale. We need families to donate baked goods.
- Maryl will be heading up the concession stand.
- We need volunteers the night before the craft fair on Friday from 6pm to 7pm depending on if there are games or practices in the gym. We need help measuring and putting tape down for the booths and lying the tarp down.

- I will be working on everything we need during Thanksgiving break and will be getting that out to the vendors and parents. Here is a list of areas where volunteers will be needed:

 3. Set up people
